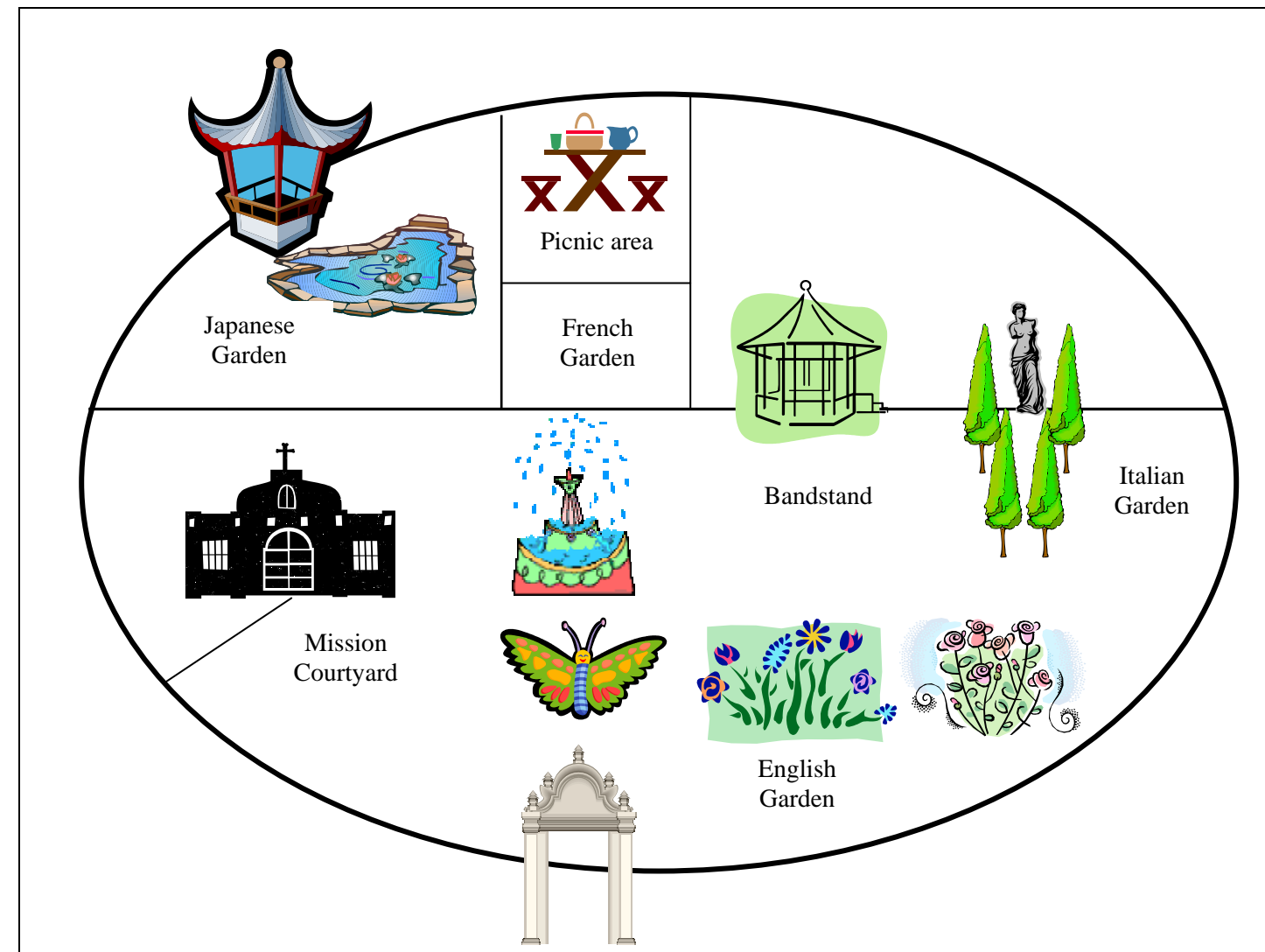


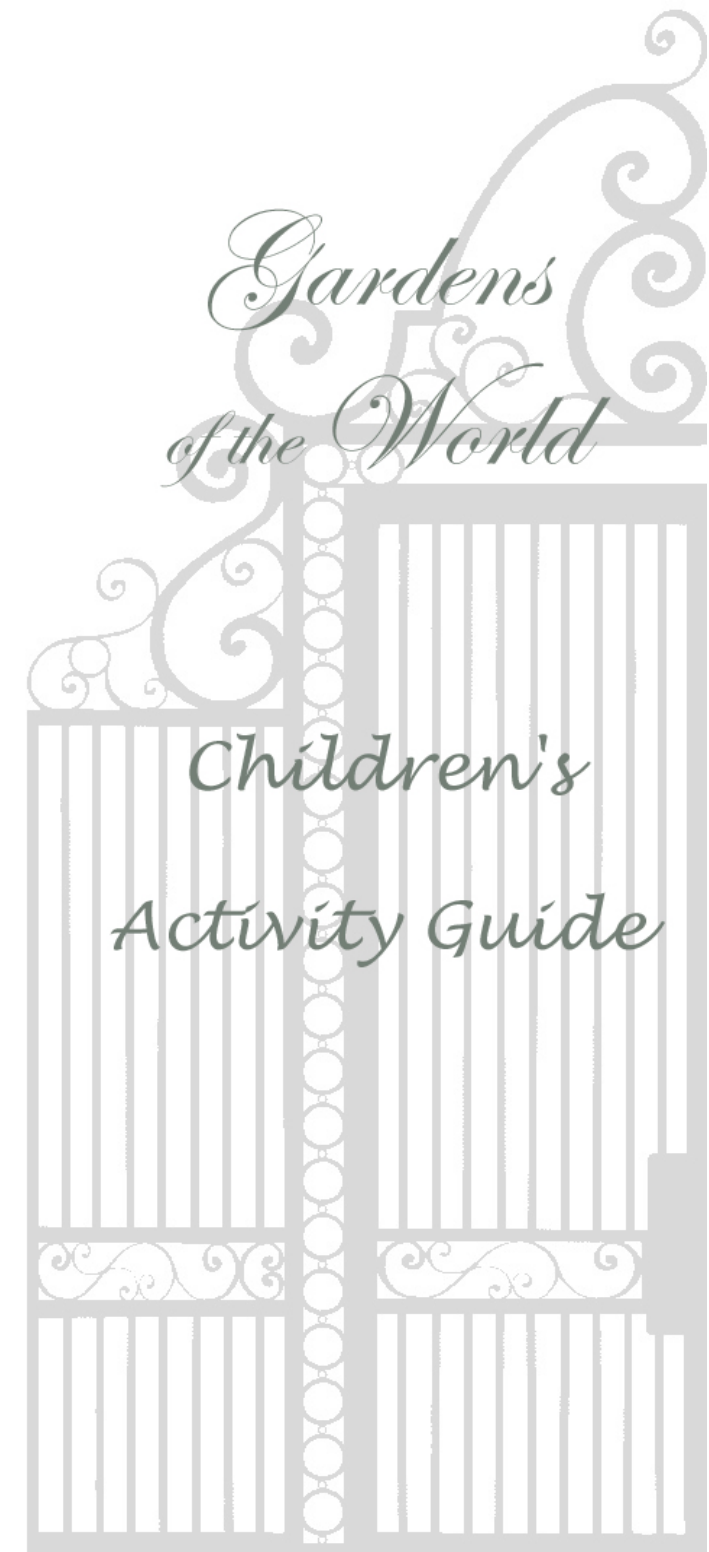
Garden Rules

- Please keep your shoes and shirts on.
- Do not feed the fish.

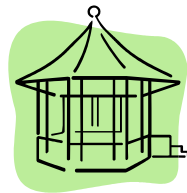


Welcome to the Gardens of the World!

Japanese Garden

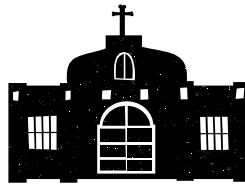


- Do you see the turtle and crane in the pond?

- Fossils show that roses are 35 million years old.

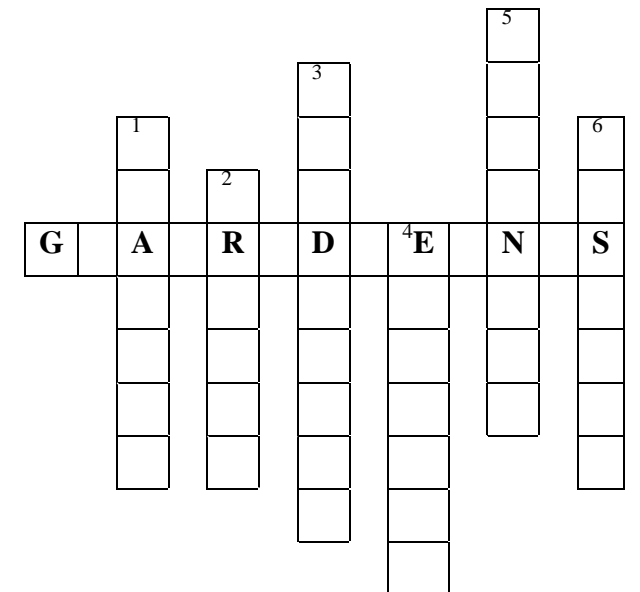


Italian Garden
