

Regulations

- Reservations are required for Docent-led tours, group visits, and photography sessions. Admission is free.
- Visitors taking photos must check in at the office upon arrival.
- No private events, parties, or ceremonies of any type are permitted, i.e. birthdays, weddings, or bridging.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Visitors, wheelchairs and strollers must remain on the sidewalks.
- Removal of plants, flowers, shrubs, fruit or signs is prohibited.
- Please keep hands, feet, and any objects out of the fountains or ponds.
- Food or Beverages are allowed <u>only</u> in the picnic area and Bandstand lawn area, please stay off the grass in all other areas of the Gardens. Picnic tables cannot be reserved. Items may not be left unattended.
- Please do not bring food or beverages into the Japanese Pagoda.
- For the safety of our guests, glass containers, barbeque grills, camping stoves, burners or fires are prohibited.
- No running on sidewalks, climbing, standing or sitting on fountains, rocks or railings.
- No bicycles, skateboards, skates, scooters, Frisbees, balls, or other sports or play equipment.
- No pets.
- No alcoholic beverages.
- No smoking or vaping.
- Shirts & shoes are required and must be worn at all times.
- Soliciting is prohibited.
- Musical instruments or radios are not allowed.

Parking

- Handicapped and limited visitor parking is available behind the Resource Center.
- Additional parking is generally available on Thousand Oaks Blvd.

Inclement Weather

 The Gardens may be closed due to inclement weather. Please call ahead to confirm or reschedule your visit.

Photography Guidelines

- A permit is required for those who wish to use the Gardens as the background for posed photography whether amateur or professional. This includes family photos, engagement, wedding, birthdays, maternity, etc. Reservations require at least a week in advance booking with dates and times subject to availability.
